NOTES:

- **NEW FOR 2020:** For 2020, theory testing is optional for students who passed level 5 theory test with at least an 85%. (Chair will let you know who they are.)
- **NOT REQUIRED THIS YEAR:**
 - MUSIC SCORES NOT required. The judge(s) feel they probably have all the music in their own libraries. However, if you want the judge to have your scores, they should be emailed directly to readingmta2020@gmail.com.
 - COMMENT SHEETS NOT required. The judge will use a Google Form Comment Sheet.

- Share the letter with your students. Decide who is doing the video and where.

Between September 11th and 5pm October 2nd:

- Student/teacher create one or two videos, upload to student/teacher YouTube account and get shareable link to use on the registration form. See letter for details.

Fri/Oct 2

- **VIDEO SUBMISSION DEADLINE 5pm.**
 - Submit links via the DSPF Registration page on the RMTA website. See letter for details. Registration may be done by the teacher, parent or student any time before deadline.
 - **Info needed for registration:** Teacher code, student last/first, instrument, test level, titles, composers, performance time, YouTube link(s).
- Chair emails theory tests and answer sheets to teachers. Teachers print and administer tests in the studio or forward to students to do at home.

Sat/Oct 3

- Registration fees due to the chair. Teachers write one check payable to RMTA to cover studio enrollment.

Oct 2-9

- Students complete tests.
- Teachers grade tests.

- Deadline for teachers to register students for state virtual event.
- **CHANGE IN STATE RECITAL REQUIREMENTS:** Student eligibility requires Superior performance rating and minimum test score of 85% on test levels P through 5. Students with a Superior Performance rating but with a theory score below 85% on Level 6 and above tests may also participate in state recitals.
