- ♦ TEACHING TIP: The term 'make-up lessons' is not popular amongst independent teachers. But it's something we all end up doing for one reason or another. Instead of doing individual lessons, hold a group session with a focus on theory. For my elementary 30-minute lesson kids, I recently held a 45-minute class on a Saturday morning. They had all started lessons in September as beginners, so it was easy to come up with a unified lesson plan.
 - Teaching theory concepts in a group setting is so much more productive for a variety of reasons. And the kids really do inspire and encourage each other in the process.
- ♦ **TEACHING TIP:** The notation software <u>Musescore</u> allows the user to create off-staff scores ideal for our pre-reading piano kiddos. You can create your own pieces or transcribe a piece for off-staff reading. And it's free!
