- 1965: Student recitals required an audition for participation. There were 6 student recitals that year.
- 1966: The first Piano Festival (monster concert) was held at Albright Field House with 24 upright pianos, 268 participants with John Harrison as the conductor. It was a fund raiser for the student scholarship funds.
- 1966: Also saw a student concerto recital.
- 1960's-1970's: All our events were advertised in the Reading Eagle -- FREE!
- There were annual member recitals at least through early 2000's with a freewill offering benefiting the student scholarship funds.
