RMTA STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS: If you have any senior students who are considering pursuing music after graduation, keep in mind the RMTA Student Scholarships. These RMTA funds are managed by Reading Musical Foundation, so check their website for dates (generally April and location (generally Immanuel UCC). Their application deadline is the end of January.

RMTA has two scholarships available – one for music major and one for non-major. Those details will be published in the annual RMF Scholarship Directory coming soon. Or, you can download last season's directory HERE to read audition requirements on page 4 and 19. But in a nutshell:

- SMITH SCHOLARSHIP: Available to graduating senior who has been accepted as a music major by an accredited school of post-secondary education by the time of the audition.
- HAAGE SCHOLARSHIP: Available to any senior accepted to a college or university and who is not enrolling as a music major but will be taking music credits.
